

## Supported Web Browsers

Officially, the Small World Labs platform supports the following web browsers:

- **Internet Explorer versions 7, 8, and 9**
- **Mozilla Firefox**
- **Google Chrome**

In some cases we will test and support for Apple's **Safari** browser as well.

## How to Update your Web Browser

### **Internet Explorer:**

Simply keep your version of Windows up to date. For Windows Vista and Windows 7 machines, automatic updates are on by default.

For Windows XP machines you can confirm automatic updates are enabled by clicking Start > Control Panel > Security Center > Automatic Updates. Now select "Automatic," then click "OK." Updates are now enabled including patches for Internet Explorer.

Legacy versions of Internet Explorer may still be running on older versions of Windows (i.e. Windows 95, Windows 98, Windows ME, Windows NT), but these are no longer supported by the SWL platform.

### **Google Chrome:**

Google Chrome automatically checks for updates and installs them when the browser is opened. There is no easy way to disable the automatic updates.

### **Mozilla Firefox:**

By default, the latest versions of Mozilla Firefox automatically check for and install updates when opening the web browser. To make sure your Firefox version is up to date with the latest version, click the "Help" tab, then click "About Firefox." This page will indicate whether or not your browser is up to date with the latest version.
